

## Terms & Conditions

- Moulton Sports Complex (MSC) shall not be liable for accidents to your child/children that are caused by third parties or for damage to a third party's property caused by your child.
- M.S.C will provide a safe and supervised environment. This will be in accordance with both the centre and OFSTEDS requirements.
- In the event of an accident to your child or sudden illness, appropriate procedures will be followed and the parent or guardian will be informed as soon as possible. Staff on the M.S.C play scheme will not administer any form of medication to your child. However children can administer medicine themselves at parents approval. (Please not a separate form should be filled in indicating this.)
- To register with M.S.C. every child must have an up to date medical form completed and signed by their parent / guardian. On this form all relevant information or medical conditions, allergies etc must be provided, along with at least two emergency contact details.
- There are a limited number of places on the M.S.C. playscheme. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis and cannot be reserved. Payment must be made in full at the time of booking, turning up at the start of a day without booking in does not guarantee a place.
- Once a booking has been made and paid for it is M.S.C. Policy that no refunds will be offered.
- Each child must be signed in and out of M.S.C by the parent / guardian. Adults other than the authorized parent/guardian of the child will require written consent before signing the child out of the camp. In addition any child wishing to go home unattended must have a signed note from their parent/guardian indicating this.
- We reserve the right to exclude or refuse any person prior to or during the M.S.C scheme
- The parent / guardians are responsible for their children before they are admitted in to M.S.C and when they leave the site.
- If your child is booked in on a Day Trip day, then by signing this you a giving permission for us to take them off site to the agreed venue.
- MSC will not be responsible for any loss or damage to property belonging to your child during M.S.C activities, or during the journey to and from M.S.C activities.
- In the event of a complaint, parents are asked initially to speak to the Playscheme Co-ordinator on site who will then take the complaint forward should the matter not be resolved immediately.
- In the event that a child is picked up late (after 5:30pm), a late charge will be incurred. (Please see Playscheme Arrivals and Departures Policy for further details.)
